Town of Campbell residents can bring to the Compost area yard clippings, leaves and branches or trees no larger than 6" in diameter. No commercial cut lumber or building materials, especially treated lumber. In the spring time or when it has rained for a few days it is a little messy, residents should try and pick drier days to drop off their material for composting. Also, no plastics to be left of any kind and no garbage. Violators will be punished.

Greetings from the Town Clerk's office. There are some changes to the election laws this year that those of us running for office would like you to be aware of. Primaries for Republicans and

Independents which were traditionally held in September will now be held on 25<sup>th</sup>. June **Primaries** will determine who is on the ballot in November for those parties. Democrats are able to Caucus until July 25<sup>th</sup> to be on the November ballot. Up for Town Elected positions this year are (2) Town Board members, Town Collector, Clerk, Tax Town Supervisor, and Highway Superintendent. As always it is important that regardless of your party affiliation you get out to vote. This is one of our most precious rights and responsibilities. I know it has been a LONG winter but it is spring time again and there are a lot of properties that are unsightly with the accumulation of junk, trash and rubbish, as well as motor vehicles. Now is the time to think clean-up! The following code sections apply. Active farms are exempt.

Town of Campbell and the New York State Property Maintenance Code Section: 302.8 Motor Vehicles: There can be only one inoperable or unlicensed motor vehicle kept or stored on any premises.

Code Section 302.1 Sanitation. States: That exterior property and premises shall be maintained in a clean, safe and sanitary condition. This means there can be no accumulation of construction waste, or house hold garbage on any premises.

Please note: the fines for non-compliance are daily fines of \$1,000 a day or a year in jail or both. Time affixed by the state for compliance is 30 days and a town cannot give any extensions.
