What is a Notary Public?

For your convenience we have 3 employees at the Town Hall who are Notaries. The process of the Notary system is:

1. A Notary attests and verifies signatures on your document, they **DO NOT** review or edit your document for errors or verbiage or content. By requesting a notary, you are attesting that you understand and comprehend the document.

2. You must sign the document in front of the Notary so that the signature can be verified to your id presented.

3. You must present a form of ID that has your signature on it.

4. All parties who need their signature notarized must be present in front of the Notary.

Please come prepared and understand that you will be required to adhere to all of the above, no exceptions will be made.

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
