
All other new exemptions need to be submitted to me by the Taxable Status Date, March 1st, 2018.

TOWN CEMETERIES
"STORIES FROM THE PAST"

This is the second in a series of articles written by Sandy Austin for the Town Newsletter about the Town cemeteries. There are some very old and interesting cemeteries which bring up some "stories from the past".

RIVERSIDE CEMETERY



Riverside Cemetery is located on County Route 125 across from the Cohocton River. Some of the burials date as far back as the 1830's but it was apparently part of the Platt Farm.

The old Town map from the earlier 1800's show a farm in this area under the name Fred T. Platt of about 272 acres. There are several of the Platt family buried there but he was not listed. Among them were Ira Platt who died in 1886 and his wife, Phebe, who died in 1895.

About that time is when the cemetery must have been divided off from the farm. In the late 1800's it had an active leadership; there were Articles of Incorporation written up dated July 7, 1891. These Articles were recorded in the County Clerk's Office on December 19, 1893. There is also a map of the Riverside Cemetery which was recorded in the County Clerk's Office in April of 1895. The actual Seal of the "Riverside Cemetery Association" is in our historical collection at the Town Hall.

It appears that the graves soon were filled and the persons caring for their loved ones' burial plots had also passed on. As the years went by, the cemetery became badly in need of maintenance. By the year 2000, this cemetery was in a sad state of disrepair with overgrown brush, broken trees and broken pipe fencing. A local Boy Scout, Stephen Nguyen, for his Eagle Scout project, cleaned up the cemetery and installed a new perimeter fence. This gave the Riverside Cemetery a much-revived look in the Town.

Riverside Cemetery is one of the abandoned cemeteries now maintained by the Town.
